

## RETURN TO ARCHERY (ENGLAND) – FROM 17 MAY 2021

OUTDOOR ARCHERY ONLY
Maintain 2 metre social distancing at all times
All must ensure they cleanse their hands before and after shooting
Minimise travel but travel for sport is permitted; Car sharing is permitted
Minimum spacing of boss centres of 3.66m
Up to 2 archers or 1 household/bubble per target boss – maintaining 2m social distancing at all times
No limits on gathering numbers for organised sport; Away from activity ensure no mixing with people from different households
1:1 permitted; Groups up to 12 archers per coach permitted <sup>1</sup>
Have a Go's – not permitted; Taster Sessions & Beginners Courses – Groups up to 12 archers per coach permitted <sup>1</sup>
Competitions are able to be run with UK & WRS but all AGB guidelines must be observed and followed

Can take place on private & public land; Social distancing rules must apply, no gatherings larger than 30

## RETURN TO ARCHERY (ENGLAND) – FROM 17 MAY 2021

INDOOR ARCHERY	
SOCIAL DISTANCING & HYGIENE	Maintain 2 metre social distancing at all times
	All must ensure they cleanse their hands before and after shooting
	Face covering must be worn throughout the venue except when actively shooting or exempt (exemptions include disabled archers and under 12s)
TRAVEL	Minimise travel but travel for sport is permitted; Car sharing is permitted
TARGET BOSSES	Minimum spacing of boss centres of 2m; Protective screens on the shooting line (not needed if target spacing is 3.3m)
CLUB SESSIONS	1 archer or a household/bubble per target boss – maintaining 2m social distancing at all times
CAPACITY LIMITS	No limits on the number of archers/volunteers; A minimum of 100 sq ft per person must be provided
COACHING	1:1 permitted; Groups up to 12 archers per coach permitted <sup>2</sup>
BEGINNERS	Have a Go's – not permitted; Taster Sessions & Beginners Courses – Groups up to 12 archers per coach permitted²
OPEN COMPETITIONS	Competitions are able to be run but all AGB guidelines must be observed and followed
